The Department of Treasury has accepted your offer in compromise submission signed and dated on December 27, 2019. The Department of Treasury has calculated that your State of Michigan tax liabilities for the above-referenced assessments will be compromised to the amount of \$1,000.00. The date of acceptance is the date of this letter. Acceptance is subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Michigan Guidelines for Offer in Compromise program and by statute. (MCL 205.23a, *et. seq.*)

The initial offer payment in the amount of \$200.00 was received on January 16, 2020. A balance of \$800.00 remains on your assessments after the accepted compromise. Your account has been set up on the payment arrangement in accordance with your submission. Five payments in the amount of \$160.00 each are due on or before the 20th of each month beginning September 20, 2020.

Please note that the conditions of the offer are subject to the terms and conditions set forth within the Michigan Guidelines for Offer in Compromise program and by statute. (MCL 205.23a *et seq.*) Failure to comply with any of the terms and conditions relative to the offer or to file subsequent required returns and pay subsequent final tax liabilities within 20 days after the department issues a notice and demand stating that the continued failure to file or pay the tax may result in the revocation of the compromise. Revocation of the compromise will consist of reinstating the

compromised tax debt along with all penalties and interest. Upon revocation of this agreement collection action will occur.
